Free 10 week full time training course which includes:



Remotely delivered Employability Workshops & Digital Skills taking place on Microsoft TEAMS every Monday and Friday 9:30 - 15:30



Project work & online learning of 2 days per week with a minimum of 3 hours per day with options of work experience

After the 10 week programme:



3 months personalised post-programme support in finding further education, training and employment

Within this programme a set pathway will be tailored to suit each individual learner's needs to increase employability whilst learning remotely.

Programme Eligibility:

- Autism, Disability
- Aged 16-25
- Living in Stoke-on-Trent or Staffordshire
- Access to a computer / tablet & internet
- Unemployed
