Introduction and Purpose



This VCSE communications toolkit has been developed to compliment Stoke-on-Trent City Council's 'Help is at Hand' campaign, supporting residents through the cost-of-living crisis.

The focus of this toolkit is bringing attention to support and services organisations like yours deliver within the VCSE sector for all members of society. This includes support for harder to reach communities and especially for those who aren't necessarily able to access means-tested support.

This toolkit also includes information on where residents can find free and/or affordable food across Stoke-on-Trent and to highlight the numerous activities taking place over the summer holidays where children (and often adults too) will be fed, and where food is available to those without a foodbank voucher. This is where '#FeedingStoke24' comes into play. Using this hashtag will ensure that the food information is easily accessible on social media.

This toolkit has also been developed in consultation with representatives from the voluntary sector in Stoke-on-Trent, members of VAST's Communications and Events Engagement Network, Stoke-on-Trent City Council, and the Stoke-on-Trent Food Partnership.

Audience(s) and Key Messages

Local voluntary sector organisations

- a. Lots of vulnerable residents are dreading the upcoming sixweek school holidays. We need to make sure that they know where they can access free and/or affordable food.
- b. Cost of living pressures are biting hard on Stoke-on-Trent residents, and we need to let people know where they can get help.
- c. Help your neighbours, residents, staff, volunteers, and service users cope with the cost-of-living crisis.
- d. The Stoke-on-Trent Community Directory is a one-stop-shop where everyone can find the support and services they need; make sure your organisation and the support you offer is listed.
- e. Welcoming Spaces provide a safe and friendly environment for people who might be struggling. Welcoming spaces are somewhere people can go to have a hot drink and maybe something to eat, charge their phones and other devices, and get some much-needed social interaction. Some even help with information and advice on money, saving energy, access to food, and more. If you're not already registered as a welcoming space, why not think about setting one up.
- f. The cost-of-living crisis is affecting people in communities; people from various backgrounds, cultures, socio-economic status, and walks of life. Regardless of circumstances, help can come in many forms and from all sorts of places.

Residents and communities.

- Vast Investing in communities
- a. The Summer school holidays are the longest school break of the year. Six weeks is a long time and for some families it feels even longer, especially when it's already difficult to access free or affordable food. We want to make sure that EVERYONE knows where they can easily access food for themselves and their families.
- b. There are lots of ways to access free and affordable food all over the city. Residents shouldn't have to travel far to find somewhere to get food.
- c. The Stoke-on-Trent Community Directory is a one-stop-shop where everyone can find the support and services they need, this includes cost-of-living support that isn't necessarily means-tested.
- d. It's important for people to seek help before crisis sets in. Just because you're working and earning a wage, it doesn't mean you aren't able to get some help.
- e. Don't stick your head in the sand support is out there and it's important to get it when you need it.
- f. There are lots of Welcoming Spaces across the city where people can go for a free cuppa and a biscuit, charge their phones or tablets, access online services, or simply to have a chat with others. Some places also offer financial, energy and other helpful advice around the cost of living.

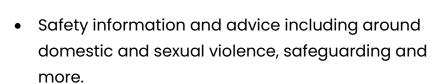
Stoke-on-Trent Community Directory

A Welcoming Space is a place of connection already established in the community (such as a community centre, library or place of faith), where people can meet up, socialise, and access support, relating to the cost of living. Services available at each Welcoming Space will vary but may include:

- access to support about money, welfare, and mental wellbeing
- community activities
- access to computers, free Wi-Fi and charging points
- heated space
